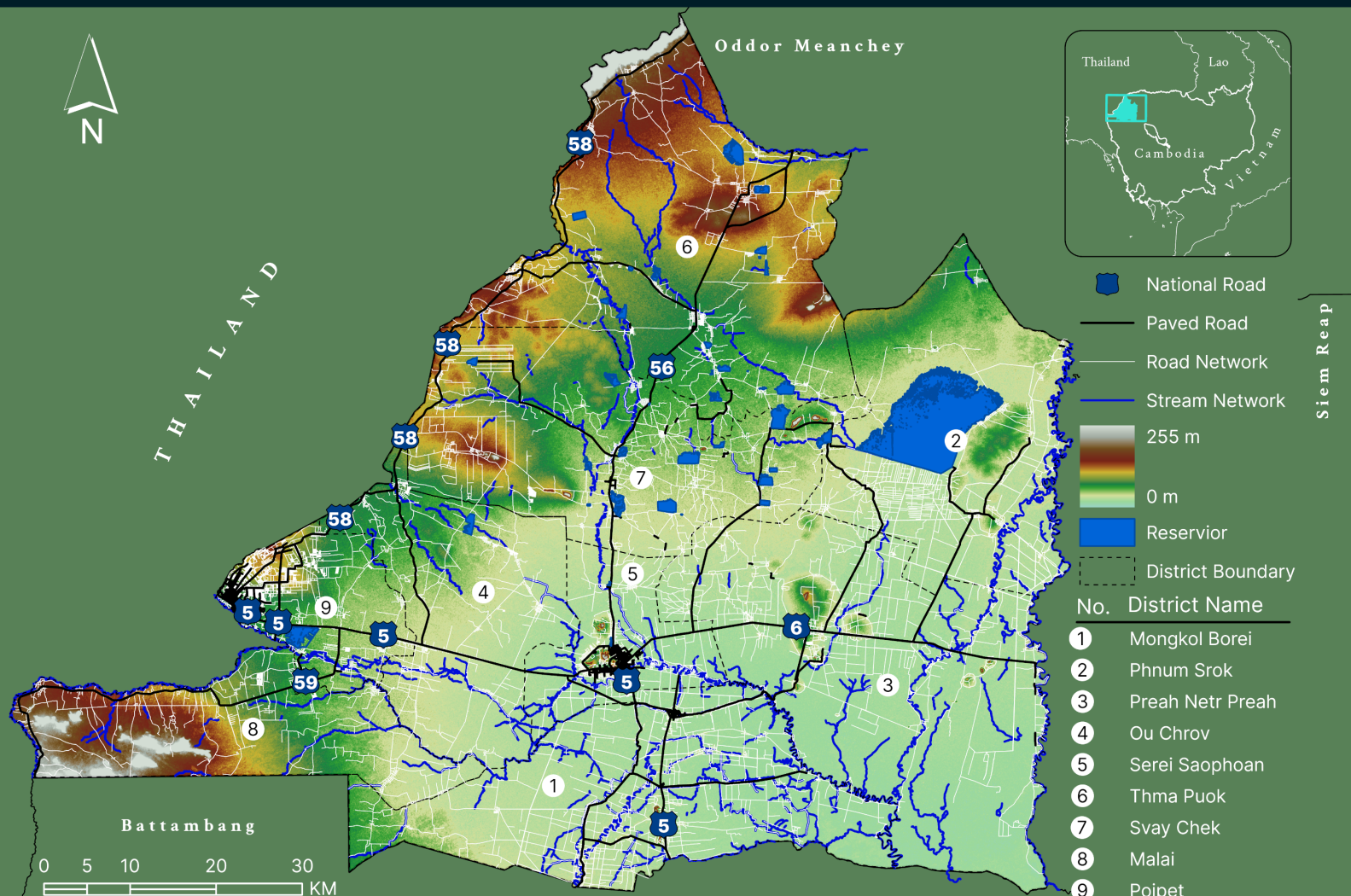


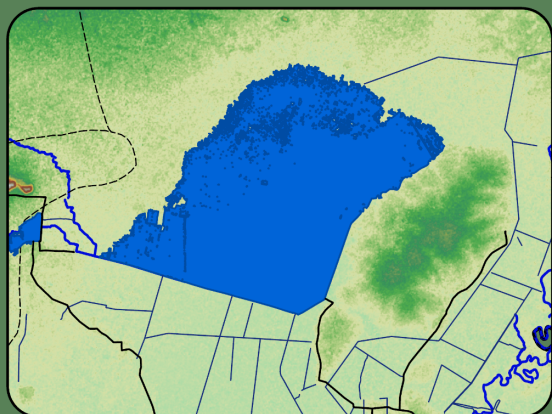
Landscape of Banteay Meanchey Province

The following map illustrates the Banteay Meanchey's landscape. Landscape of the province is characterized by a low-lying plain that increases in elevation on northern and south-west of the province to a height of about 250 meters above the sea level. Banteay Meanchey is consisted of multiple reservoirs, stream networks and inter-connected water channels.
